This gentleman was admitted from the Advanced Cosmetic Surgery where he had a banding operation done on his stomach, subsequent to which he developed nausea, vomiting and severe right sided chest pain. We got him reviewed by our surgical colleagues who felt that he does not need any surgical intervention at this stage. We performed a VQ scan, which did not confirm a PE and we treated him conservatively with IV fluids for his pre-renal failure. We also got him reviewed by our renal colleagues.

He was discharged home on One Alpha, Ciclosporin, Cellcept, Zantac, Innovace, Frusemide, Rhinocort, Pravastatin, Tipuric, Colchicine and Cipramil. He will be reviewed in Beaumont Hospital in the renal outpatients clinic.
